In accordance with SB 316, Charter schools may now establish their own Proof of Residency Policy. The Board of Directors at Mt. Auburn International Academy's revised policy is stated below:

Every parent enrolling their child in MAIA is required to provide one (1) proof of residency. They may choose any one (1) item from the list provided. This one item needs to be dated within the last 30 days, unless it is a lease or rental agreement.

This same format applies to any parent changing the address of their student who attends MAIA.

If the parent or guardian is unable to provide proof, due to living arrangements (living with a friend or relative for example) they will need to have the person they reside with provide proof of residency (again, the same guidelines stated above) as well as get the Property Owner Affidavit and Parent Residency Affidavit form filled out and notarized before we will accept it as proof of their address. The parent will also need to provide one document within thirty (30) days that has their own name and address that they reside at printed on it.

These are the guidelines that MAIA will follow when enrolling a new student, or changing the address of the current student.
